Since her establishment, COGS actively serves the community through initiatives like Boys' Brigade and Girls' Brigades, impacting lives from childhood to parenthood. An annual highlight 'Christmas in Queenstown', a European-style Christmas market, also aims to spread festive cheer and the gospel message to the community.
