COLLECT

Twentieth Sunday after Trinity

Eternal Father, whose Son Jesus Christ ascended to the throne of heaven that he might rule over all things as Lord: keep the Church in the unity of the Spirit and in the bond of his peace, and bring the whole created order to worship at his feet, who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, now God, now and forever. Amen.

Parish of the Week – Marine Parade Christian Centre

Started as a house church in 1976, Marine Parade Christian Centre (MPCC) is one of the few parishes that was birthed during the renewal period in the Diocese.

In 2012, MPCC planted Chapel of Christ our Hope, a church that embraces families with all abilities, neurotypical and those with special needs.

Today, MPCC has 1 Mandarin service and 2 English services, one of which is anchored by the Filipino and Youth ministries. The church also has several active groups such as Cycling, Cooking, Hydroponic Farming and Karaoke to strengthen community life and for outreach.
