#### **TraceTogether-only SafeEntry**

Please note that from 1 June 2021, only the TraceTogether app or token will be accepted for SafeEntry check-in to our premises. This contact-tracing system is mandatory in accordance with government regulation for places of worship with more than 100 people. With this, other modes of SafeEntry check-in - such as scanning a SafeEntry QR code with a phone camera or the Singpass app, will be discontinued.
