1. Launch of Caleb Fellowship wef 25 September 2021

Requirement For “Vaccinated” Status at Saturday Service wef 18 Sept

As announced, the seating capacity for Saturday service will increase to 100 attendees wef 18 September. For entry screening purposes, attendees must bring your TraceTogether. In accordance with government requirements, entry will only be allowed for those who are “vaccinated”. You are considered “vaccinated” if you have:

- (a) been fully vaccinated with Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna or WHO EUL vaccines, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective,
- or
- (b) recovered from COVID-19,
- or
- (c) obtained a negative ART or PCR test taken after Friday 6.00 pm or on the Saturday itself, at an approved medical clinic.

The Sunday 9.00 am service capacity will remain at **50** attendees, with no entry requirement to check for “vaccinated” status. This will allow those who are unvaccinated yet for various reasons, to be able to attend onsite church services.
