Sermon Title : Trying to run away from God!

Text : Jonah 1

COLLECT

Pentecost (*Whitsunday*)

Almighty God, who at this time taught the hearts of your faithful people by sending to them the light of your Holy Spirit: grant us by the same Spirit to have a right judgement in all things, and evermore to rejoice in his holy comfort; through the merits of Christ Jesus our Saviour, who is alive and reigns with you in the unity of the Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen

Mission and Purpose: As we see the gracious salvation plan in the missional heart of God, may we be a missional church of Spirit-filled committed disciples of Jesus Christ, always ready to take the gospel to the nations.

What is Whitsun?

Whitsun is Old English for “White Sunday” and also known as Whitsunday. It is the forty-ninth day (seventh Sunday) after Easter Sunday. In the Christian calendar, it is also known as Pentecost, commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples.

Pentecost commemorates and celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit in the form of flames to the followers of Jesus as recorded in Acts 2:1–31. Jesus had told them to wait until the Spirit came to them. Ten days after Ascension, Fifty days after the Resurrection, the Spirit came.

Pentecost is recognized as the birth of the Church because when the disciples received the Holy Spirit, they began to go out and preach about Jesus. The Apostle Peter preached a sermon which resulted in 3,000 people becoming believers. Traditionally, Whit Sunday is a favourite day for Baptism. It is thought that because people are often baptized dressed in white, Whit Sunday was probably originally known as “White Sunday”.
