Luke 15:1-10

#### COLLECT

### **Thirteenth Sunday after Trinity**

Lord God, the protector of all who trust in you, without whom nothing is strong, nothing is holy: increase and multiply upon us your mercy, that you being our ruler and guide, we may so pass through things temporal that we finally lose not the things eternal. Grant this, heavenly Father, for the sake of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

# The Glory of God in the Imitation of Christ – Slaves and Master Ephesians 6:5-9

"Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ ... doing the will of God from the heart ... Masters, do the same to them ..." Ephesians 6:5, 6 & 9

Paul is speaking to the Ephesians considering the cultural relationships that they had at their time. In the Roman empire at that time, slaves and masters were very much a part of society. Apparently, some slaves and some masters had become followers of Jesus. How should they handle those relationships? Again, Paul points to mutual love and submission to one another as the solution.

Roman slavery has both similarities to and differences from paid work in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. The chief similarity is that both ancient slaves and contemporary workers serve under the authority of supervisors. About the work itself both groups have a duty to meet the expectations of those in authority over their work. The chief difference is that ancient slaves owe not only their work, but also their lives to their masters. They do not receive pay or compensation for their work and negotiate working conditions. To certain extent, the teaching of this passage is relevance for the 21<sup>st</sup> century paid workers as we have supervisors over us or staff under us.

In God's family, every person is equal and valued. So, inside the church, slaves are not to be treated any differently than anyone else and have the same rights. Outside the church, slaves are to follow the rules of the government. So, Paul taught believing slaves what they should know and how to act.

Paul prescribes the attitude that slaves are to have toward their masters. Slaves are to treat their masters with honour. Honouring a master means being respectful, polite, and obedient. A slave who honours his master would be loyal and a hard worker. On the other hand, grumbling, complaining, bitterness, or gossiping about a master are all the opposite of honouring him. Employees should be respectful to their bosses and seek to win them to Christ through their actions. Our attitudes and behaviour at work should be a testimony for Christ and bring people to Him, not repulse them.

Some Christian slaves had Christian masters. They may have thought that since they were brothers in Christ, they were not obligated to fulfil their responsibilities. Being tempted to take advantage of the good graces and forgiveness of their bosses, they might become lazy and disrespectful. Paul warns them that this is the wrong track. Instead, they should work even harder to bring blessing to their believing bosses. To slaves, he would emphasize obedience. And to masters, he would emphasize justice and mercy. You may have a Christian boss. If so, do not take advantage of the mercy he shows. Do not think, "I can show up late because he will forgive me." His goodness is not something to be exploited. Instead, be an even better and more diligent employee, knowing that it is a member of God's own family who is benefiting from your hard work.

Masters are to treat their slaves well, with honour and respect. They should recognize that the Master in heaven was watching them. He was not partial and would not be impressed with their wealth or position. He would judge them for their treatment of their slaves.

Each of us, no matter what position of authority we have, should remember that we have a higher authority in heaven. God will hold us accountable for how we treat the people under our care, whether they are students, children, or employees. What is one way we can improve as an authority to those under us?

#### Talk it over

- 1. How can you partner with other Christians at your job to affirm your boss?
- 2. How can you as a superior at your job to affirm your subordinates?
- 3. Consider how you are functioning in your roles and relationships in your workplace. Are you showing proper honour? Are you showing proper love? Are you humbly submitting?
- 4. Show love and submission to someone in your workplace this week. Share your experience.
