1. Tenth Bishop of Singapore

The Provincial House of Bishops has appointed Rev Canon Dr Titus Chung, aged 55 years, as the tenth Bishop of Singapore. Canon Titus is currently the Priest-in-charge of St Andrew's Cathedral Mandarin Congregation. He is also the Convenor of Continuing Ministerial Education for Clergy & Deaconesses and a member of the Senior Clergy Planning Team. Canon Titus will be consecrated and installed on Sunday 18 October 2020. Value your prayers for Canon Titus and his family as they prepare for his new appointment and heavy responsibilities.
