We are thankful that from 5 April 2021, the government has given approval for congregation attendees to sing aloud at our church worship services, subject to safe management measures of (1) mask-wearing at all times, and (2) the duration of masked singing is capped at a total of 30 minutes at each service. ***Let us make a joyful noise unto the Lord.***
