For the past one year, I have been using an app that provides information prayer pointers from **“Operation World”** to guide me in my daily prayer for the nations. You can download this free app on your mobile phone or laptop using this weblink <http://www.operationworld.org/prayer-app/> I find the information very useful to understand each country and the various people groups, which guide me to pray specifically for each nation of the world everyday. It has helped me to see the power and grace of God at work in all these nations.

Currently, this app is only available in English. There is a printed version of **“Operation World”** in Mandarin. If you need help to buy a copy, please speak with the church staff for assistance.

May we grow in our prayer life daily. May the Lord open our eyes and heart as we pray for the nations, especially for the unreached peoples.
